Effective January 1, 2024

We take seriously our responsibility to provide safe, reliable energy at reasonable rates. We work hard to control our costs.

In 2023, MGE filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to increase electric and natural gas rates in 2024. The PSCW approved some changes, setting our electric and gas rates.

Overall electric rates will increase 1.54% in 2024. Electric costs for 2024 include investments made in the West Riverside Energy Center, solar investments and continued investments in grid modernization projects. The collection of the escrow accounts for uncollectible costs, including costs related to COVID, also are included in electric costs for 2024.

The approved natural gas distribution and gas supply service rates reflect an overall increase of 2.44% across all customers in 2024. The primary reasons for the gas increase are continued investments in system modernization projects to maintain a safe and dependable system and the collection of the escrow accounts for uncollectible costs, including costs related to COVID.
