Madison Gas and Electric Effective Jan. 1, 2025 MGE takes seriously our responsibility to provide safe, reliable, affordable and sustainable energy. We are sensitive to the impacts our costs have on our customers, especially our customers who struggle to meet essential needs. We continue working hard to contain costs throughout the organization while advancing cleaner energy for the benefit of all our customers.

Effective Jan. 1, 2025, electric rates changed.

In 2023, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) approved MGE's application to adjust electric rates in 2024 and 2025. As part of the regulatory process, in 2024, MGE submitted an application to the PSCW for approval of its 2025 fuel cost plan, which lowered the previously approved 2025 electric rates.

Although fuel costs are expected to decrease in 2025, overall electric rates will still increase due to investments in solar and in grid modernization projects previously approved by the PSCW. With the proposed fuel adjustment, overall 2025 electric rates will increase by 2.07% from 2024.

- The typical residential electric customer using 500 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month will see an increase of about \$4.57 a month.
- Impacts for non-residential electric customers vary by rate class.

Effective Jan. 1, 2025, natural gas rates changed.

In 2023, the PSCW approved natural gas rates for 2025 that reflect an increase of 1.13% in overall rates from 2024.

- The typical residential natural gas customer using about 720 therms a year will see a monthly bill increase of about \$0.94 a month.
- Impacts for non-residential natural gas customers vary by rate class.
- The primary reasons for the increase in natural gas rates are continued investments in system modernization projects to maintain a safe and dependable system.
